POLICY

Application

This policy shall apply to The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness (and all services operated by or under contract with it.

1.0 Research

Research is defined as a systematic investigation, including research development, testing and evaluation, designed to develop or contribute to generalized knowledge.

- 1.1 Authorization of any research effort requires The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness CEO approval of a comprehensive research plan.
- 1.2 Individuals shall demonstrate informed consent or refusal and expression of choice related to their involvement in research projects
- 1.3 All research efforts shall adhere to research guidelines, approved plan, and ethical standards, as set forth in the State and Federal regulations regarding research and the protection of human subjects.
