Chairperson McKinstry notified Board members that other Recipient Rights Advisory Committees in the state have their own by-laws as the committee is separate from the Board. Discussion was held regarding this issue and it was decided to not create Committee by-laws at this time.

CEO Possehn and Linda Purcey referenced the Daily News article that was included in the Board packet. The article highlighted Kassondra Purcey (Linda's granddaughter) telling her success story of dealing with persistent personal issues while growing up and her transformation.
