POLICY

Application

This policy shall apply to The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness and all services operated by or under contract with it.

- 1.0 Purpose:
To ensure that recipients of mental health services are permitted treatment by spiritual means.
- 2.0 Policy:
A recipient of The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness services shall be permitted treatment by spiritual means on the request of the recipient, the recipient's guardian, or a parent of a minor recipient.
- 3.0 Monitoring and Review:
This policy is reviewed by the Recipient Rights Office. It is reviewed and monitored internally by the Recipient Rights Advisory Committee and the Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness Board. It is monitored externally by the MDHHS.
