POLICY

APPLICATION

This policy shall apply to Ionia The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness and all services operated by or under contract with it.

1.0 **Purpose**:

To establish guidelines to promote the dignity and respect of recipients of mental health services and their families.

2.0 **Policy:**

- A. All recipients of mental health services shall be treated with dignity and respect.
- B. Family members of recipients of mental health services shall be treated with dignity and respect.

3.0 Responsibilities:

- A. The Recipient Rights Officer is responsible for ensuring that procedures to implement the intent of this policy are developed, reviewed, and revised as necessary.
- B. All staff are responsible for treating recipients and their family members with dignity and respect.

4.0 **Monitoring:**

This policy is reviewed annually by the Recipient Rights Advisory Committee.
