POLICY

Application

This policy shall apply to The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness.

1.0 Compliance

It is the intent of The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness to comply with all applicable federal and state laws and regulations, affiliation policies and regulations, and accreditation standards. To ensure compliance, The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness will establish and maintain a Compliance Plan and Standards of Conduct for the purpose of assuring ongoing compliance, reporting potential violations, investigating reported compliance issues, and resolving confirmed violations and addressing areas of concern, as appropriate.

Authority is vested by the Board in the CEO for the overall implementation and oversight of the Compliance Plan and Program. The CEO shall designate a Compliance Officer and Compliance Committee as outlined in the Compliance Plan.

The Compliance Plan and Standards of Conduct will be reviewed and evaluated on an annual basis by the Board.
