## **Application**

#### 1.0 Research

- 1.2 Individuals shall demonstrate informed consent or refusal and expression of choice related to their involvement in research projects
- 1.3 All research efforts shall adhere to research guidelines, approved plan, and ethical standards, as set forth in the State and Federal regulations regarding research and the protection of human subjects.
