POLICY

This policy shall govern the actions of The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness during the selection, award, and administration of contracts.

1. Application

No employee, officer, or agency shall have any conflict of interest, real or apparent, during the selection, award, or administration of a contract supported by a Federal award. This will be applicable to any individual involved in the process with a financial interest or tangible personal benefit associated with the award including employee's immediate family members, partner, or the employer of a family member or partner.
