### POLICY

#### Application

This policy shall apply to The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness and all services operated by or under contract with it.

#### 1. Research

- 1.1. Research is defined as a systematic investigation, including research development, testing and evaluation, designed to develop or contribute to generalized knowledge.
- 1.2. Authorization of any research effort requires The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness CEO approval of a comprehensive research plan.
- 1.3. Individuals shall demonstrate informed consent or refusal and expression of choice related to their involvement in research projects.
- 1.4. All research efforts shall adhere to research guidelines, approved plan, and ethical standards, as set forth in the State and Federal regulations regarding research and the protection of human subjects.
