POLICY

APPLICATION

This policy shall apply to The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness and all services operated by or under contract with it.

1. Purpose

To establish guidelines to promote the dignity and respect of recipients of mental health services and their families.

2. Policy

2.1. All recipients of mental health services shall be treated with dignity and respect.

2.2. Family members of recipients of mental health services shall be treated with dignity and respect.

3. Responsibilities

3.1. The Recipient Rights Officer is responsible for ensuring that procedures to implement the intent of this policy are developed, reviewed, and revised as necessary.

3.2. All staff are responsible for treating recipients and their family members with dignity and respect.

4. Monitoring

This policy is reviewed annually by the Recipient Rights Advisory Committee.
