**POLICY**

This policy shall govern the actions of The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness during the selection, award, and administration of contracts.

**1.0 Application**

No employee, officer, or agency shall have any conflict of interest, real or apparent, during the selection, award, or administration of a contract supported by a Federal award. This will be applicable to any individual involved in the process with a financial interest or tangible personal benefit associated with the award including employee’s immediate family members, partner, or the employer of a family member or partner.
