PROCEDURE

Application

This procedure shall apply to the clinical services of The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness.

1. Psychiatric Rehabilitation Services

1.1. The Right Door provides psychiatric rehabilitation services for both mental health and substance use disorders.

1.2. The Right Door clinical staff will provide direct referrals to psychiatric rehabilitation services if The Right Door does not provide them.

1.3. Services include:

1.3.1. Supported employment designed to provide those receiving services with on-going support to obtain and maintain competitive, integrated employment.

1.3.2. Other psychiatric rehabilitation services that might be considered:

1.3.2.1. Medication education;

1.3.2.1.1. Medication education is provided by nursing staff at the time of the health screening.

1.3.2.1.2. Medication education is also available on The Right Door's website

1.3.2.1.3. Medication education is also provided by connecting persons served to ongoing needed medical care through primary care providers or specialty referrals.

1.3.2.2. Self-management; training in personal care skills; dietary and wellness education

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1.3.2.2.1. Dietary and Wellness education is provided by Peer supports and Peer Recovery Coaches.

1.3.2.2.2. Dietary and Wellness education is also provided by partnering with community agencies like MSU Extension.

1.3.2.2.3. Budgeting, voting, shopping and more are also available training to persons served.

1.3.2.3. Individual and family/caregiver psychoeducation;

1.3.2.3.1. Psychoeducation is provided by clinicians to individuals and families.

1.3.2.3.2. The Right Door utilizes Family Psychoeducation for families.

1.3.2.4. Community integration services;

1.3.2.4.1. The Right Door is focused on full integration of those we serve into the communities they choose.

1.3.2.4.2. The Right Door has care coordination agreements with housing providers, school providers, employment providers and other community providers to assist in community integration.

1.3.2.4.3. The Right Door officers Drop- In Center for adults with or in recovery from a mental illness or co-occurring substance use disorder.

1.3.2.5. Recovery support services

1.3.2.5.1. Recovery support services are provided by Peer Support Specialists, Peer Recovery Coaches and Parent Support Partners.

1.3.2.6. Find and maintain stable house.

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1.3.2.6.1. The Right Door employs an outreach coordinator who partners with housing providers to assist persons served in obtaining stable housing.

1.3.2.6.2. Case managers are trained in community housing resources.

1.3.2.6.3. The Right Door is a part of the local Housing Coalition.
