PROCEDURE

Application

This procedure shall apply to The Right Door for Hope, Recovery, and Wellness and all services operated by or under contract with it. This procedure shall serve as a guide to assure compliance with Board policies regarding Recipient Rights.

1.0 Sterilization, Abortion, Contraception

The primary clinician for a person served shall provide persons served, their guardians, and parents of persons served who are minors with notice of the availability of family planning, and health information services, and upon request, provide referral assistance to providers of such services. The notice shall include a statement that receipt of mental health services shall not depend in any way on requesting or not requesting family planning services or health information services.
