## PROCEDURE

## Application

This procedure shall apply to the clinical services of The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness.

- 1. Persons served will be provided a provider listing in their orientation packet. Persons served may find the listing on the agency website and may request an additional copy at any time. Persons served will be offered a list annually.
- 2. The choice of the person served of service providers shall be respected and, whenever possible, accommodated.
- 3. When choice of providers cannot be met fully, mutually acceptable alternatives shall be offered:
  - 3.1. All requests and rationale for accommodating the request shall be documented in the file of the person served.
  - 3.2. Potential alternatives shall be identified and documented by The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness staff.
  - 3.3. The choice of alternate provider of the person served, or the reason for not accepting an alternate provider, shall be documented.
- 4. If an acceptable alternative cannot be negotiated, inform person served of right to contact the Program Manager. The Program Manager will consult, mediate and/or intervene as necessary.
- 5. The CEO shall render the final determination on all disputes of provider of choice.
